

Category	Description	Criteria/Consideration
Most Improved Club	Awarded to a club that has a shown significant improvement in comparison to the previous academic year in more than one of the following areas: · Performance in BUCS or equivalent · Recruitment and retention of members · Communication and engagement with both club members and the wider community e.g. press coverage, websites, social media · General team organisation · Service to members e.g. offering a wide range of team activities such as socials, tours, volunteering as well as the provision of training and matches · Pro-active efforts to be inclusive of students of all abilities and backgrounds · Engagement with the students' union	Voted for by Students
	Awarded to the club that has offered the best service to its members and has	

Awarded to the club that has offered the best service to its members and has contributed the most to the development and promotion of sport at City St George's University.

Voted for by Students

Team of the Year	This trophy is awarded for outstanding sporting success in the current season. Any sports team that has competed on behalf of City St George's University in a BUCS or equivalent competition is eligible for this award.	Voted for by Students
Service to Sport Award	Given in recognition of an individual (player, committee member, coach, fan or other) who has shown remarkable commitment to a particular City, St George's sports team and/or sporting community. They will have gone above and beyond what is expected to make a significant impact on sports at City St George's. This may include catalysing improvements of, or ensuring the success of, training sessions, matches, team volunteering, charitable fundraising and other team related events. Likewise, sporting events and initiatives.	Voted for by Students
Sport Person of the Year	Awarded to a City St George's sports team member who has made a significant impact on their team with their performance on the pitch/court.	Voted for by Students


Tooting Specific Awards

Georgia McCoy Award (Sports Person of the Year)	Team member who made a significant contribution to their team on the court/pitch. Significant impact on results. This could be a positive impact on training, positive sporting behaviour, available for most sporting fixtures. This was named after Georgia McCoy who sadly passed away late 2023	Voted for by Students
Sports Club of the Year	Awarded to the club that has offered the best services to its members. They have provided a positive impact on the sporting community and performed well in recruiting and retaining members. They have offered a wide range of socials, volunteering opportunity, training and matches and well attended students' union events such as Fresher's Fair, Varsity	Voted for by Students
Sports Team of the Year	Outstanding sporting success in the current season, clearly stated which team of the club (1st, 2nd etc)	Voted for by Students

Tooting Specific Awards

Contribution to Sport Award Awarded to player, committee member, fan, coach or other who has gone above and beyond or shown remarkable commitment to a particular club this can Include improvement on training, matches, volunteering, charitable causes or brought about significant positive change for sport at the university.

Social Media Champions	The Social Media Champion Award is awarded to a a team that has displayed strong online presence and social media usage, meeting the criteria stated here	Voted for by Students
Club Colours	Club Colours can be awarded to sports team members (a maximum of 2 per team) provided they meet the criteria. Club Colours are awarded to City St George's sports team members who have provided outstanding service to a team. They must have shown outstanding commitment in at least one of the following areas: attendance at training, availability to play matches, team organization, team volunteering activities, and/or team charitable fundraising. Club Colours are a great chance to celebrate the 'unsung heroes' in our sports teams as well as the 'stars'. Being a team captain by no means automatic qualificationfor club clouors. Nominations are open to any registered member of club and Can only be awarded once. Criteria must be 3 out of 4 below - Over 80% attendance at training/fixtures, available for all fixtures, assisted in teams/clubs organisation and admin duties. stepped in as coach/umpire/referee to help sports department/club outs	Voted for by Staff

All Sites Awards

Half Colours	Half Colours are awarded to any number of sports team members or individual competitors who have been selected for a BUCS/SESSA or an equivalent students' competition to represent on a regional level or selected to compete at the regional level in a national competition (including non-student competitions). For example, an active member of the City St George's rugby team who has been selected for England Rugby's London & Southeast Senior Academy in the current season.	Half Colours can only be awarded if the student was selected to compete at the regional level in the current season and is also an active sports team member or individual competitor for City St George's. Voted for by Staff
		Full Colours can only be awarded if the student was selected to compete at the

Full Colours

Full Colours are awarded to any number of sports team members or individual competitors who have participated at the national or international level after a selection process. For example, they have been selected for an England, Wales, or Scotland national team (student or non-student squad).

Awarded to a team that has made an outstanding effort to be inclusive and can demonstrate it is supportive of equity, equality and diversity for and in its membership.
